## **Lesson Plan for Grandparents Day**

Celebrating Grandparents Day Honoring Grandparents **Grades K, 1, 2** 

This is a wonderful opportunity to honor grandparents on Grandparents Day or any day throughout the year.

- 1. Discuss with the students the importance of Grandparents.
  - a. What do your Grandparents do for you?
  - b. What do you like to do with your Grandparents?
  - c. How do you show your Grandparents that you love them?
- 2. Ask the students to bring in a picture of grandparent(s) and share their favorite memories of their Grandparents.
  - a. What did you do?
  - b. When did this happen?
  - c. Why was it so special?
- 3. Have the students decorate a frame for their picture. (The frame can be cardstock that is cut to fit the picture leaving a 1" border on all sides for coloring and designing.)
- 4. As the children finish, tell them that displaying pictures is one way to honor our grandparents. Explain the importance of honoring our Grandparents.
- 5. Teach them "A Song for Grandma & Grandpa" which is the official song of National Grandparents Day! Kids love to sing the song and it's a great way for them to express their love for their Grandparents!

Preferably the students could display their frames and sing the song together at a class or school assembly. Many schools have a day designated to celebrate Grandparents Day and could incorporate it into that event.
